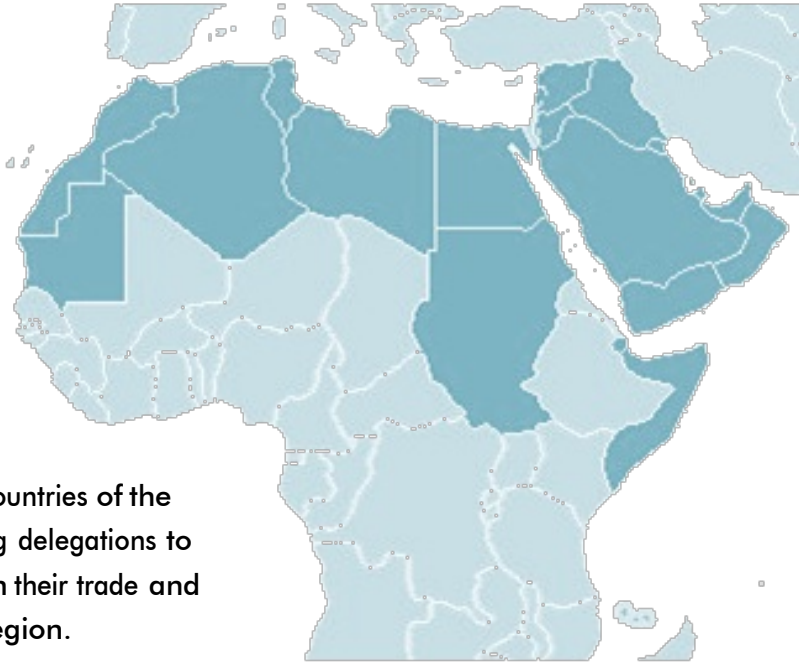




## MISSION STATEMENT
